

Selection process

- Analysing partners' needs for Specialist Art Nouveau Terminology through creating draft collections of candidate terms being provided in mailing interaction
- Selecting terms for Style classification differentiating Art Nouveau content
- Revising the choice dividing between concepts usable for indexing and concepts not applicable for cataloguing
- Selected terms will characterize national, regional or artist/form specific subtypes


