A state-funded organisation of the Ministry of Culture of the Czech Republic



Since the mid-1970s it has been based in the Baroque Manhart Palace (Celetná 17, Prague 1)





The Arts and Theatre Institute

- Provides comprehensive services in the field of the theatre and individual services in other branches of the arts (music, literature, dance, visual arts)
- □ Gathers, processes, and makes accessible artefacts connected with the field of theatre
- □ Conducts scientific research
- Publishes expert literature
- Has 65 employees − 1/3 of whom are part time
- Is funded by the Ministry of Culture of the Czech Republic, almost 30% of its income comes from its own revenue

Is an institute focusing on information, research, consultation, education and production in the field of the theatre and performing arts, i.e. including opera, ballet, stage dance, puppet theatre, and other forms

➡ Is a centre that concentrates on information, consultation, education, and production in the field of the arts and in particular the theatre, music, dance, visual arts, and literature



Possesses


- one of the largest theatre libraries in Europe

- And is one of the most important publishers of theatre literature in the Czech Republic

- Maintains a detailed record and monitors Czech theatre
- ♣ Pursues a programme of scientific research on the history of Czech theatre





Engages in collection work in connection with stage and costume designs



- ♣ Presents and promotes Czech theatre abroad via
 - year-long projects
 - independent exhibitions, workshops, seminars, and theatre presentations
 - ➡ preparation of specialised materialsand publications on Czech theatre for use abroad
 - the organisation of exchange and residence programmes for theatre artists and scholars
 - the organisation of the Czech Theatre Showcase







- Organises the Prague Quadrennial of Performance Design and Space
 - an international showcase of stage design and theatre architecture
 - ₱ since 1967
- ➡ Is responsible for the operations of the offices of the Czech national centres of international non-governmental theatre organisations
 - □ ITI, UNIMA, ASSITEJ, SIBMAS...

 - Information on people, organisations, and the musical arts scene in the CR

 - Promoting Czech literature in the CR and abroad







- Provides consultation on concepts and financial support for arts and culture projects from domestic and foreign programmes and funds
 - Emphasis on using resources from the European Union
- Conducts research projects, mainly in the field of cultural policy



Runs the Artists in Residence programme for various fields of the arts (visual arts, literature, performing arts...) and the residence programme at the Egon Schiele Art Centre (Český Krumlov)
